Running for DCA State Office Campaign Speech & Headshot Tips



STATE OFFICER CANDIDATE:

Election Day will be your opportunity to share information about yourself and your vision for the Delaware Career Association. Below are a few guidelines to help you prepare.

CAMPAIGN SPEECH Length: 2 minutes (max)

When writing your speech, it is important to share information that your peers can relate to and support. Share your story by touching on the following:

- The reasons you believe you will make an ideal student leader.
- 1-2 goals you would like to achieve during your time in Office.
- Any strengths that make you a good fit for the position.

SPEECH DELIVERY

- When addressing the audience, you may memorize your speech or use note cards to help you remember important points you would like to convey.
- Be sure to speak clearly and slowly.
- Stand straight up and make eye contact with the audience as you speak.
- The more you read your speech, the more comfortable you will be on stage, so remember to practice beforehand.

HEADSHOT

Candidates must submit a headshot to be included on the ballots. Photos should be professional and against a solid white background/wall. Photos must not include any other people, pets, objects, frames, or filters. Photos taken on a phone or tablet will be accepted.
